



Hampstead School of English Accommodation Fees

Studios

A studio apartment consists of one room used for both living and sleeping. The School owns several houses containing studios between 15 and 20 minutes walking distance from the School. All studios have modern furnishing, televisions, modem outlets with ISDN broadband access (data only - no voice), study space and good storage space. All our studios are newly refurbished to a high standard and all have their own private shower room and toilet. Some studios contain small kitchenettes, some share a communal kitchen (3 to 4 studios per kitchen) and others have their own en-suite kitchen. All are supplied with bed linen and towels and kitchens are all fully equipped.

Homestay

Students stay with a local host, which may be a typical 'family' of husband, wife and children, or a couple or a single (often retired) person. London is a cosmopolitan city with many different types of people from many different backgrounds and this is reflected in our home stays.

Every Hampstead School of English host enjoys welcoming foreign students to their home. Students are treated as though they are a member of the household and are expected to adapt to the home stay life and routine. They generally eat their meals with their hosts and spend varying amounts of free time with them. No more than three adult students are accommodated at any one time. We ensure that there is only one student of each mother tongue in the house, unless there are exceptional circumstances, such as students are travelling together or by special request. It is possible for two friends to book a shared room in a home stay; however we do not select shared accommodation for students travelling alone.

Rented Rooms

Rented Rooms are similar to home stays in that the owner is a resident but students do not live in a family environment and therefore students will have more independence than they would have in home stay accommodation. Rooms are rented to students and the owner, or 'manager', is on hand to help with any problems with the accommodation that the students may have. Private homes may accommodate more than four adult students at the same time however some private homes may only accommodate one or two students. There is a set mealtime for dinner and the bathroom is shared with other students and often the owner/manager of the accommodation

Brigette Krafczyk Residence (formally London Lodge) offers single, double or twin rooms with mid-week dinners and private bathrooms. This residence is a 25 minute walk to school and the students are always very well looked after by Brigette, the owner. Prices from £280 to £420 per week.

Kings College is available 03/07 – 13/09 and is just a 2 minute walk from the school and offers single and twin rooms. It is a student hall of residence for Kings College students and is a typical example of this type of accommodation. The price for this is £245 for bed and breakfast and £301 for half-board.

Usher Hall is a 25 minute journey by bus to the school and offers single rooms with private bathrooms and self-catering facilities. Again, it is available 03/07 – 13/09 The price per week is £210.

International Student House is located just opposite Great Portland Street tube station which is very central but only a 25 minute journey to school. They can do single, twin, triple or quad bedrooms and although mainly have shared bathroom facilities they do have a small number of en-suite rooms. A single room with shared bathroom is £259 per week and a twin is £203 per week per person including breakfast.

Accommodation London Hostel is based in a really lovely residential area in Willesden Green and a short walk from the tube station. The rooms have been recently refurbished and is in great condition and is also very clean and tidy. There are a number of rooms that can sleep from 2 up to 10 people and are offered with self-catering facilities. The price is £20 per night per person.
